

2023 Chi Epsilon Sigma Child/Grandchild Higher Education Scholarship



Two \$250.00 scholarships will be awarded.

Applications must be turned into the Scholarship Committee by March 17, 2023.

What is the purpose of this scholarship?

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a current Chi Epsilon Sigma (CHIES) member's child or grandchild who desires to further their education at an institute of higher learning such as college, university, or vocational school.

Who is eligible to apply for this scholarship?

Children and grandchildren of current CHIES members who have graduated from high school and plan to enroll at an institute of higher learning.

When should you apply for this scholarship?

Applications are now being accepted through March 17, 2023. Only one submission per member will be considered.

How will the scholarship be awarded?

The scholarship will be based on a 500-word essay written by the applicant stating why they would like to further their education. Grades, school/community activities, and special interest of the student may be listed in the essay, but the scholarship will not be awarded based only on these items. Applications will be reviewed, and winners selected by an independent committee.

After judging of essays, scholarship funding will be awarded to recipients after proof of enrollment is confirmed by the institution and approved bythe scholarship committee. Upon receiving this information funds will be distributed before the fall semester to the individual.
