

2025 Chi Epsilon Sigma Child/Grandchild Higher Education Scholarship



Two \$250.00 scholarships will be awarded.

Applications must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by March 7, 2025.

What is the purpose of this scholarship?

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a current Chi Epsilon Sigma (CES) member's child or grandchild who desires to further their education at an institute of higher learning such as college, university, or vocational school.

Who is eligible to apply for this scholarship?

Children and grandchildren of current CES members who have graduated from high school, and plan to enroll at an institute of higher learning.

When should you apply for this scholarship?

Applications are now being accepted through March 7, 2025. Only one submission per member will be considered.

How will the scholarship be awarded?

The scholarship will be based on a 500-word essay written by the applicant stating why they would like to further their education. Grades, school/community activities, and special interests of the student may be listed in the essay, but the scholarship will not be awarded based only on these items. Applications will be reviewed, and winners selected by an independent committee.

Recipients must provide proof of enrollment confirmed by the institution to be approved by the scholarship committee. Funds will be distributed to recipients prior to the start of the fall semester.
