



2025 Chi Epsilon Sigma Member Higher Education Scholarship



Two \$100 scholarships will be awarded.

Applications must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by March 7, 2025.

What is the purpose of this scholarship?

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to a current Chi Epsilon Sigma (CES) member who desires to further their education at an institute of higher learning (college, university, or vocational school). This scholarship is not intended for members who attend special interest classes, leadership workshops, or short term trainings.

Who is eligible to apply for this scholarship?

Only current CES members will be considered for this scholarship.

When should you apply for this scholarship?

Applications are now being accepted through **March 7, 2025**.

Only one submission per member will be considered.

How will the scholarship be awarded?

The scholarship will be based on an essay (between 500 and 550 words) written by the applicant stating why they would like to further their education.

Applications will be reviewed, and winners selected by an independent committee, thus allowing board members and committee members to be eligible.

Recipients must provide proof of enrollment confirmed by the institution to be approved by the scholarship committee. Funds will be distributed to recipients prior to the start of the fall semester.
